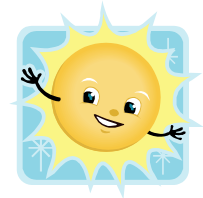
Summer '09 **Week Five**

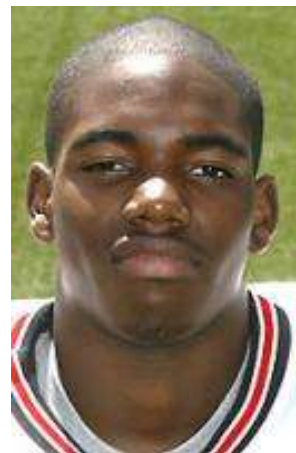
